Slash neck dress

Looking for the perfect outfit tonight? Elevate your style with this sleek dress featuring a slash neck, a sleeveless bodice, shirring at the waist, and a chic knee length. Designed for stretch knits, this body-hugging silhouette will make you feel comfortable and confident. Create it in no time and get ready to make an impact!

1 cm seam allowance included!

Material

- 140 x 150 cm 4-way stretch jersey with spandex
- All-purpose thread
- Stretch needle
- Twin stretch needle
- 35 cm clear elastic (0.5 cm wide)

Print & Assemble

Front

- First, be sure to use ACROBAT READER to open your PDF sewing patterns. It's free!
- Then, open your file and click on the LAYERS icon (left side of the screen) and uncheck all the sizes you won't need.
- Now, click on the PRINT icon at the top of the screen. The print settings will appear, so verify that the ACTUAL SIZE option is checked. Click on the PRINT button!

• A 5 x 5 cm (and 2 x 2") control square is provided to ensure that your pattern is true to size.

Back

• To ASSEMBLE, cut the sheets at the bottom and right margins, as indicated. Each sheet is labelled with a letter and a number (AI, B2...), so tape them together in numerical and alphabetical order. The sheets on one row should have the same letter, and the ones on the same column should have the same number.

Sizing Guide

Garment measurements

• Length: approx. 96 cm



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Pattern Pieces

- Back neckband, lx fabric
- Back, 1x fabric
- Front, 1x fabric
- Elastic length, 2x clear elastic
- Armhole bands, 2x fabric

Sewing Assembly

Unless otherwise specified, sew using a **1 cm** wide seam allowance.

- 1. Fold the back neckband lengthwise and sew it to the back neckline (stretch to fit).
- 2. Place the front and back right sides together and fold the front neck hem (turn once 4 cm) over the back.
- 3. Sew the shoulders and unfold the neck hem.
- 4. Sew the side seams.
- 5. Apply the clear elastic on the seam allowances, between the markings (stretch to fit).
- 6. Sew each armhole band at the short sides. Fold lengthwise and sew to the armholes (stretch to fit).
- 7. Hem the bottom of the dress with a twin needle (turn once 3 cm).



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
